Illinois Yellow Dot Program

The Illinois Dept. of Transportation unveiled the Illinois Yellow Dot program, a life saving traffic safety initiative that provides first responders with critical information to improve emergency care for persons involved in vehicle crashes. This program is a statewide initiative designed to provide vital medical information on vehicle drivers/passengers.

Here is what you need:

<u>Photograph</u> - a photo, clearly identifying program participant, must be placed in the designated spot on the Yellow Dot Medical Card.

<u>Personal Information</u> – this must include: participant's name, emergency contact, personal physician, medical conditions, recent surgeries, allergies and current medications. Completed form goes in your glove compartment.

<u>Yellow Dot</u> – Decal must be placed on the rear-facing window on the driver's side. This alerts first responders of vital medical information that can be found in the glove compartment.

Information contained on this medical card assists first responders immediately following a serious crash.

Stop by the Clerk's office to pick up your "yellow dot" kit now. There is no fee for this service.
